### Tournament Limits

In order that a player will not obtain an unfair advantage over other players simply by playing in more tournaments, each player will only be allocated points based on her best 5 tournament finishes out of a maximum of 10 tournaments.

### USGA Women's State Team

The selection of the biennial three-woman USGA Women's State Team will be based upon the final USGA Women's State Team standings for 2017. The USGA Women's State Team standings are determined by combining a player's previous year's point totals with points awarded through August 15<sup>th</sup> of the current year multiplied by 2. Those golfers ranked in the top three of the standings will qualify for the team. The 2017 NWAGA Senior's Championship will not be included in the point standings.
