NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NWAGA Championships & Events)

Abnormal Ground Conditions:

Flower and Plant Beds and their Rock Borders are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines.

The Tree Farm Located Right of Hole #15 is deemed to be ground under repair.

Deciding Ties:

In the event of a tie for the winner in championship flight, the winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off. In the event of ties for all other flight winners or positions within a flight, the combined prize monies will be divided.

Integral Part of the Course:

The Rail Road Tie Walls within the Lateral Water Hazards Between Holes 13 & 16 are deemed to be an integral part of the course, therefore, no relief without penalty.

Obstructions:

Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel or asphalt.

Prepared Flower Beds adjacent to Immovable Obstructions have the same status and are considered one obstruction.

The Tennis Courts and Chain Link Fence between Holes 4, 5, & 6 is deemed to be an immovable obstruction.

The Cart Shed Area Defined with Orange Stakes is deemed to be an immovable obstruction.

Yardage Posts are deemed to be Movable Obstructions.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence and white lines in addition to white stakes. When defined by white lines, the line itself is out of bounds.

Out of Bounds is defined by the base of the wall between the white stakes behind the teeing ground on Hole #1.

Hole #9 - Out of Bounds behind the green to the right is defined by the white line in addition to the white dots.

Scoring Area:

Scoring Area – A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring area.

Teeing Ground:

Red tee-markers define the teeing ground.

Temporary Immovable Obstructions

Water Pipes above the level of the ground are deemed to be a Temporary Immovable Obstruction (TIO). The Local Rule as prescribed in Appendix I of the Rules of Golf is in effect. In addition to the available relief options under the Rules, a player having interference (either physical interference and/or intervention) from the TIO may drop a ball, without penalty, on either side of the TIO, but not nearer the hole.

Wrong Putting Green:

Practice Putting Greens are deemed to be wrong putting greens.
