Tournament Limits

In order that a player will not obtain an unfair advantage over other players simply by playing in more tournaments, each player will only be allocated points based on her best 5 tournament finishes out of a maximum of 7 tournaments. If a player participates in more than 10 tournaments in a single season, points will only be given for her best 5 finishes of the 10 tournaments in which she plays.

Doubling of State Sponsored Events

Double only state sponsored events in a team competition year. Since this team is representing the State, it should be comprised of State tournament participants and winners. Points from the previous year and doubled current year points will be totaled to select the team. The Senior's Championship will not be included in the points standings.
