NOTICE TO PLAYERS

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NWAGA Competitions)

Format:

Net Four-Ball Match Play. In each race, a side is awarded one point for winning a hole, ½ point for halving a hole and 0 points for losing a hole. The maximum number of points a team can win in any match is 6; the minimum is 0. The side in each flight with the most points after all five races shall be the flight winner.

Teeing Ground:

Red Tee-Markers define the teeing ground for this competition.

Abnormal Ground Conditions:

Decorative Flower Beds including all rock beds are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines.

Hole #3 - The pampas grass located behind the putting green on hole #3 is deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines. The player may take relief under Rule 25-1.

Newly Planted Trees defined by an orange stake are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines. Relief may be taken for interference of lie of ball, stance or area of intended swing involving the tree.

Drop Zones:

Water Hazard on Hole #3 - As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the Water Hazard (yellow), the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked "DZ" located in the fairway.

Water Hazard Behind the Putting Green on Hole #9 - As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the Water Hazard (yellow) located behind the green, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked "DZ" located right of the green.

Water Hazard Behind the Putting Green on Hole #10 - As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the Water Hazard (yellow) located behind the green, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked "DZ" behind the green on the right.

Lateral Water Hazard Behind the Putting Green on Hole #11 - As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the Lateral Water Hazard (yellow) located behind the green, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the closest of the two areas marked "DZ".

Obstructions:

Artificially surfaced roads and paths include those surfaced with crushed rock, gravel and asphalt.

Railroad tracks and the rock bed bordering the tracks are deemed to be an immovable obstruction.

Hole #14 - The white stakes along the right side are deemed to be immovable obstructions.

Flower and plant beds enclosed by cart paths or adjacent to immovable obstructions are deemed to be part of the obstruction. Rule 24-2.

Immovable obstructions adjacent to each other are to be treated as a single obstruction. Rule 24-2.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence and white lines in addition to white stakes.

Hole #13 - The white stakes along the right side are Out of Bounds during play of Hole #13 only.

Deciding Ties:

The side with the most points at the end of the five matches wins their flight. If there are ties within a flight, the ties will be broken and the winner determined as follows: 1. By the result of the head to head match. 2. Highest point total on day 1 (matches 1, 2 & 3 combined). 3. Highest point total on day 2 (races 4 & 5 combined). 4. Most points in match 1. 5. Most points in match 2. 6. Most points in match 3. 7. Most points in match 4. 8. Most points in match 5. 9. By lot.
