FORMAT

Senior Stroke Play Championship – 54 holes. Lowest score for 54 holes will be crowned champion. If any players are tied for first place in the Championship Flight only, a playoff will occur. In the event of ties for first place in all other flights or positions within a flight, merchandise prizes will be divided equally and distributed. Duplicate medals will be awarded to ties for non-championship flight winners. The entire field will be flighted following round two based on individual 36-hole gross score.

For those that registered with a teammate, the first 36 holes will also include a (net) Eclectic event. The eclectic event consists of two individuals playing as partners; each partner playing their own ball. Participants receive 75% of their Course Handicap. For the first 18-holes, the lower net score of the partners on each hole is their team score for that hole. During the second day of competition they can better their score on a hole-by-hole basis to determine an 18-hole overall score for the event.

Daily Breakdown:

Round One, Monday, August 6 - 18-holes, stroke-play.

Paired with eclectic partner and another team (group of four) based on team handicap. Individual players will be paired together or with an eclectic team.

Round Two, Tuesday, August 7 - 18-holes, stroke-play.

Paired with eclectic partner and another team (group of four) based on round one eclectic score. Individual players will be paired together or with an eclectic team based on round one score. Merchandise Prizes for the eclectic event will be awarded to top third following round two. Medalist award for the participant with the lowest 36-hole gross score. Flights created based on 36-hole score for final round of Senior Stroke Play Championship.

Round Three, Wednesday, August 8 - 18-holes, stroke play.

Individuals paired in groups of four based on their 36-hole gross score. Awards for flight winners and merchandise prizes to top finishers in each flight.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

All contestants should register with NWAGA prior to the first round on Monday, August 6. Registration will be set-up in the clubhouse from 6:45 a.m. to 8 a.m.

PRACTICE AREAS

The practice range will open at 7 a.m. each day of competition. Complimentary range balls will be available on the driving range.

DRESS CODE

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. NWAGA has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Absolutely no metal spikes.

CADDIES and CARTS

The cost of automotive transportation (cart) is included in the tournament entry fee. If you prefer to walk you may carry your own bag, use a pull cart, or provide your own caddie. Caddies represent the player and any conduct of the caddie will reflect on the competitor.

GROUPS AND STARTING HOLES

Groups and starting holes for Monday's 8 a.m. shotgun start will be available on the tournament web site Wednesday afternoon (August 1). Groups and starting holes for Tuesday and Wednesday's 8 a.m. shotgun starts will also be available on the tournament web site following the prior round.

HOSTED LUNCHEONS AND OTHER FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE

A hosted luncheon will take place following round one on Monday, August 6. An awards luncheon will follow play on Wednesday, August 8. The clubhouse will be available for any other food and beverage purchases throughout the competition.
