**NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

(This notice supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NWAGA Competitions)

**Dropping Zones:**

Water Hazard on Hole #6 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the water hazard, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ”.

Water Hazard on Hole #7 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the water hazard, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ”.

Water Hazard on Hole #8 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the water hazard, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ”.

Water Hazard on Hole #12 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the water hazard, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ”.

Water Hazard on Hole #14 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the water hazard or lateral water hazard, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ” on the forward teeing ground.

**Obstructions:**

Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel or asphalt. Maintenance paths between holes are not considered obstructions.

Decorative rock adjacent to artificially-surfaced roads and paths are deemed to be the sides of the roads and paths, thus they are all one Immovable Obstruction. Rule 24-2.

Elevated Bird Houses on posts are deemed to be Immovable Obstructions.

**Out of Bounds:**

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes and lines.

The Clubhouse Parking Lot is out of bounds. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies on or beyond the cement edge.

Hole #3 - Out of Bounds is defined by the white line on the left side and behind the putting green in addition to the perimeter fence and white stakes.

Hole #5 – Out of Bounds is defined by the road behind the putting green. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies on or beyond the road.

Hole #7 - Out of Bounds is defined by the white line on along the cart path left of the putting green.

Hole #17 – Out of Bounds is defined by the road along the left and behind the putting green. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies on or beyond the road.

**Play-Off:**

In case of a tie for the championship flight winner, concerned players shall immediately play-off hole-by-hole until a winner is determined.

**Teeing Ground:**

The Red Tee-Markers define the teeing ground.

**Water Hazards & Lateral Water Hazards:**

Hole #2 – The Water Hazard on hole #8 is deemed to be a Lateral Water Hazard during play of hole #2.

Hole #15 – The Water Hazard on hole #14 is deemed to be a Lateral Water Hazard during play of hole #15.

Hole #16 – The Water Hazard on hole #12 is deemed to be a Lateral Water Hazard during play of hole #16.
