REGISTRATION: On Monday, players are requested to check in upon arrival at the registration table

located on the patio outside the golf shop. Registration will open at 9:30 a.m.

PRACTICE AREAS: Range balls will be available on the practice range for pre-round practice only.

CARTS: Carts were included with entry and will be staged outside the golf shop each morning.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE: NWAGA will provide a sack lunch during golf on Monday and an awards Luncheon after

play on Tuesday.

FORMAT: Four-person modified scramble. Each player plays from the teeing area on each

hole, one of the tee shots is selected and all the players play their second shots from that spot. One of the second shots is then selected, and all players play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed. This format is modified as follows: The player whose shot is selected does not play the next shot (exception: on the putting green, all team members may putt). Each team

member must contribute at least four tee shots.

DIVISIONS & FLIGHTS: All sides compete in both gross & net divisions. Up to four flights will be created

in advance based on Team Handicap Index . If two or more teams have the same team handicap, the order will be determined by the team with the lowest handicapped player. Merchandise prizes will be awarded to the top gross and net finishers in each flight (can only win the higher flight merchandise award

amount in either gross or net).

DETERMINING TIES: All ties will be broken by scorecard playoff using the USGA method of comparing scores.

PRIZES: Net: Overall Low Net: Pewter cup awards; Merchandise: Top two teams in each flight

both Gross and Net Gross: Overall Low Gross: Trophy plates.

ELECTRONIC SCORING: It is required that one individual in each group enter gross hole scores following each

hole using the Golf Genius mobile app. Instructions for downloading the app are

available by linking here.
